Our meal pick up and meal delivery will continue to be on Wednesdays only. Meal pick up will still be at McNabb from 11:30-12:30. Children will receive meals according to the following:

- 100% Virtual: 5 lunches/5 breakfasts
- Hybrid: 3 lunches/3 breakfasts
- Non-Student: 5 lunches/5 breakfasts
