**Background Checks for Parent Members**

KRS 160.380(10) requires SBDM parent members to submit to State and Federal criminal records checks. If a SBDM parent member is re-elected to a **consecutive** term, then the school district is not required to conduct these criminal records checks again. However, if there is a "break in service" and the SBDM parent member is elected later, but not consecutive to an initial term, then the school district should conduct a new State and Federal criminal records check. **SB 128 and Councils**

If your district decides to grant the "do-over" year to students in your district, it is wise for the council to discuss guidance received from the Board of Education and Superintendent and impact on your school.
