Northview did not have 100% participation. 55% of incoming K needed Intervention. 40% = grade level; 5% = ready with Enrichments. Mrs. Harman will be sharing this data with Kindergarten Teachers. A typical year will entail earlier sharing. Mrs. Harman & Mrs. Lansdale went through the list to make sure all students in K needing intervention were being serviced2. RTI is up and going. ALL students K- 5 receive intervention outside of their Reading Block. We have 2 ESS Teachers, 2 Classified, 1 Reading Interventionist, and Mrs. Harman & Mrs Lansdale have Reading groups along with classroom teachers.3.
