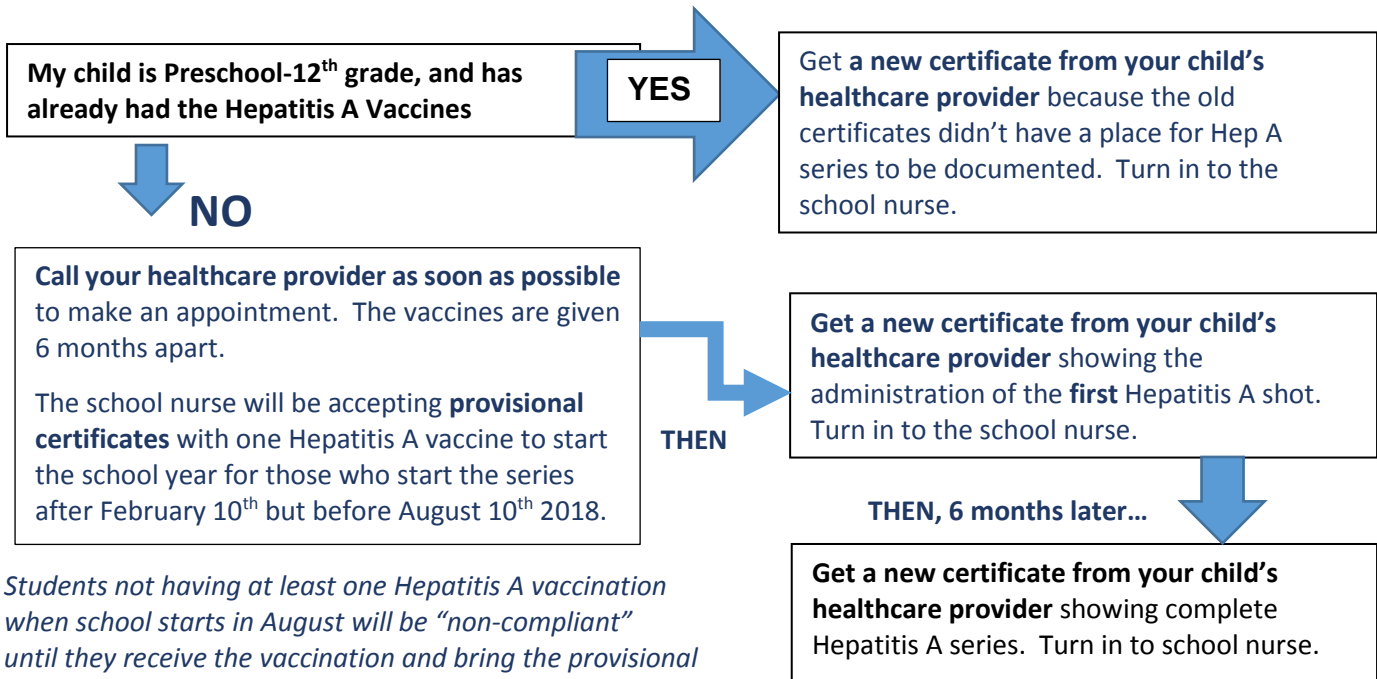


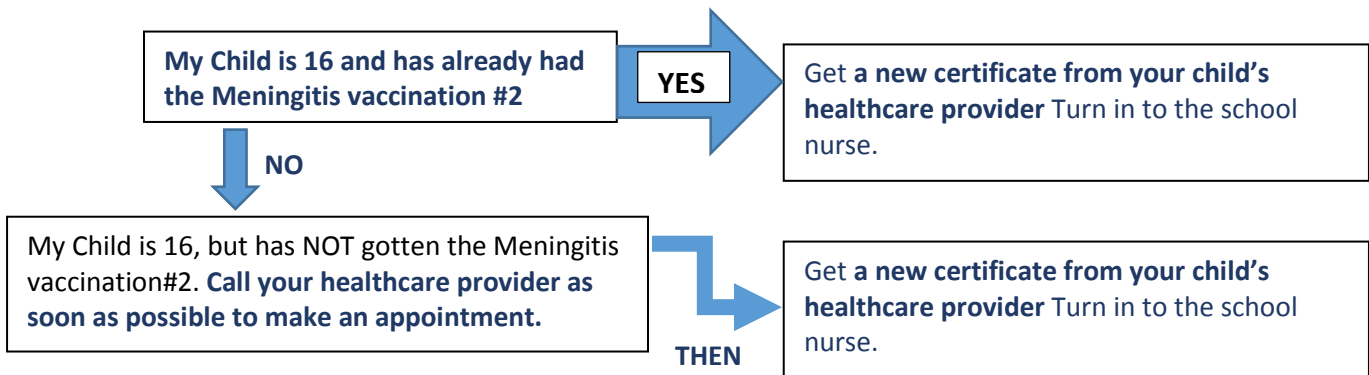
As of July 1, 2018 Hepatitis A series is a required immunization for all students Pre-12, and an additional Meningitis vaccine is required for any student 16yrs and older. The following is a breakdown of these new requirements as they may apply to your student in Pre School-12th grade in Montgomery County Schools.

HEPATITIS A VACCINATION SERIES OF 2



Students not having at least one Hepatitis A vaccination when school starts in August will be “non-compliant” until they receive the vaccination and bring the provisional certificate to the nurse.

MENINGITIS #2 VACCINATION



Students that are 16, but have not received the MCV4 #2 vaccination when school starts in August will be “non-compliant” until they receive the vaccination. Each month, notifications will go out to those whose students turn 16 as a reminder.

As I’m sure you can see, the prevailing message is **contact your healthcare provider, get a new certificate** for proof of vaccination, **get your student scheduled as soon as possible**. As of 2018 there is a new KY certificate that has places for all vaccines now required. It is online and is easily accessed by your provider.
